More space for paediatric and adolescent rehabilitation and new special

With an increase in floor space of around 15 per cent compared to the previous trade fair, there are currently signs of a particularly high level of participation in the area of paediatric and adolescent rehabilitation.

For the first time, prosthesis manufacturers and suppliers such as PROTEOR, APT Prothesen and INNTEO will be brought together in a new special show entitled 'Mobile with a prosthesis'. The concept and supporting programme for this was developed in cooperation with the Bundesverband für Menschen mit Arm- oder Beinamputation e.V. (BMAB). In addition, the trade fair programme will focus on the topic of 'Stroke', which will be examined from the perspective of specialists as well as patients and relatives and will be represented by the three players Stiftung Deutsche Schlaganfall-Hilfe and the trade journals not and Gesundheitsprofi.
